Israeli Soldier Dies In Lebanon; 600th Casualty Since 1982

TEL AVIV (WNS) -Israel Force soldier, shot in South Lebanon Oct. 20, died of his wounds, bringing the casualty toll in Lebanon to 600 killed and nearly 5,600 wounded since Israel invaded Lebanon in June, 1982.

The soldier identified as 30-year-old Alon Tsur, a corporal from the northern border kibbutz settlement of Shamir, was hit by fragments of a rocket terrorists fired at his army vehicle near the Zaharani river bridge.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -Seven terrorists were killed and three Israel Defense Force soldiers were wounded in two separate incidents in South Lebanon, recent-




