The sample ballots for the November 6th General Election have been mailed. It is extremely important that everyone retain the sample ballot and take it to the polling place.

Besides the elective offices, the sample ballots contain some 14 questions and the explanations of and arguments for and against passage of each question.

Time limits make it prohibitive to wait until a voter goes to the polls to become acquainted with this material.

Nevada Revised Statute 293B.320 states "A voter shall not remain within the voting booth longer than 2 minutes. If he refuses to leave it after the lapse of 2 minutes, he may be removed by the election board."

To help prevent long lines from forming at the polling place, please read your sample ballot, make your choices and remember - "TAKE YOUR SAMPLE BALLOT WITH YOU."
