

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) — Defense Minister Yitzhak Rabin has informed the Knesset that West Bank representatives will not be permitted to go to Amman for a meeting of the Palestine National Council. Replying to questions by MKs of the Progressive List for Peace, Rabin stated that Israel regards the PLO as a terrorist organization and therefore cannot permit West Bank residents to attend a meeting designed to further the interests of the PLO.

PARIS (WNS) — French writer Marek Halter announced here that an agreement has been reached between the City of Paris and the Ministry of Culture for the creation of a Jewish museum in Paris. Halter, active in intellectual circles, said the city and the ministry will share the costs of creating it and operating it.

NEW YORK (WNS) — The memoirs of Arno Herzberg, who managed the Berlin office of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency from 1935 to 1938, have been accepted for the archives of the Yad Vashem in Jerusalem. Herzberg, who heads an accounting firm in Union, N.J., is a regular contributor of news articles to the American Jewish press.

TEL AVIV (WNS) — An IDF soldier was wounded in South Lebanon when two rockets and automatic weapons fire was directed at an Israel army post near Lake Koroun, on the eastern border.

TEL AVIV (WNS) — An Israeli soldier, severely wounded when his convoy was ambushed near Sarafand in South Lebanon died in a Haifa hospital. His death brought to 602 the number of deaths of Israeli army personnel since the invasion of Lebanon in June 1982. It was the second IDF fatality in South Lebanon in November.

VIENNA (WNS) — A bomb exploded in front of the Vienna office of the Israel airline El Al. Nobody was hurt, and the damage was only slight. One hour before the bomb went off, a similar device exploded in front of the British Embassy. No one was hurt either.

NEW YORK (WNS) — Lyndon LaRouche, head of a political cult group and an independent candidate for President of the United States, lost the libel suit he brought against the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith and NBC-TV. A six-person jury in the Federal Court of the Eastern District of Virginia said that the ADL had not defamed LaRouche when it described him as an "anti-Semite" and a "small-time Hitler."

BONN (WNS) — The West German television station ZDF is preparing two half-hour films on tourism in Israel. The films will deal with Jerusalem, Eilat, the Dead Sea, the Negev, life in a kibbutz and archaeological excavations in Jericho. Israeli writer Ephraim Kishon, who is extremely popular in West Germany, even more so than in Israel, will narrate the first film.

NEW YORK (WNS) — Perhaps the most unique ballot cast in the U.S. presidential election was by a Moscow Jewish refusenik, Abe Stolar, who was born in Chicago. He confirmed that he recorded his vote at the American Embassy in the Russian capital in a phone call with friends in Detroit, according to the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry. Stolar grew up in Chicago and graduated high school there. He was brought to the USSR in 1931 by his parents.
