## Peres Tells Tel Aviv University Forum: Peace, Not Victory, Is The Real Success

TEL AVIV — Israeli Prime Minister Shimon Peres called last week on President Hosni Mubarek of Egypt to revive the spirit of Camp David and "demonstrate that peace — far more than victory in war — is the real success."

Addressing a seminar at Tel Aviv University marking the sixth anniversary of the Camp David accords, Mr. Peres said Israel would pursue a strategy for peace patiently, despite apparent Arab disinterest.

"We are not deterred by the replies and refusals we are getting from Arab sources, particularly King Hussein," Prime Minister Peres said, adding:

"Nor do we seek mutuality only. Our task is to cultivate the existing treaty with Egypt and prepare the ground for peace with our immediate neighbor, Jordan. And we shall never cease repeating that peace is needed by all of us, for the good of all of us, and the sooner the better."

Noting that Egypt had asked for "confidence-building measures" by Israel, Mr. Peres said: "Our answer is a series of steps aimed at improving the quality of life for residents of the West Bank and Gaza. We will do what we can to assure that their feelings are respected, their lives protected and their personal freedoms guaranteed."

In urging a "return to the atmosphere of Camp David," the Israeli Prime Minister declared: "We must clear the air and raise our relationships with Egypt to a higher level. We will not content ourselves with merely non-belligerency or formal relations.

"Let us seek opportunities for trade, for technological and cultural exchanges, for free travel between our countries. Let us enlarge these contacts and let us try to find additional partners. Let us demonstrate that peace — far more than victory in war — is the real success."

## Gilman Hosts Children Of The Holocaust

MONSEY, New York — At a press conference held in his Monsey, New York, Congressional Office, Rep. Benjamin A. Gilman (New York - 22nd District) stated that "Nazi war criminals have no legal right to remain in America."

Congressman Gilman's statement was made at a press conference in Monsey for the Second Generation of Rockland, an organization of children of Holocaust victims.

Mrs. Esther Pal of Spring Valley is the Chairman of the organization.

In his remarks, Rep. Gilman said that "as Americans, who cherish the principles of civil rights and justice, we cannot tolerate such criminals living in our country."

"I will continue to support the special investigations being conducted by the Justice Department," stated Gilman, "until all Nazi war criminals living in America are investigated and deported."

Also attending the press conference, in addition to representatives of the local media, were: Mr. and Mrs. Alvin Goodman and Mrs. Esther Ingber, of Monsey; Mrs. Eva Nordhauser and Mrs. Anne Katz of Suffern; Toby Frishman of Nanuet; Randy Ziring of New Hempstead; Marc Berkowitz of New City; and Rabbi Allan Meyerowitz of Spring Valley.

The members of Rockland's 2nd Generation presented Congressman Gilman with a petition signed by 2,400 individuals urging the continuation of the Justice Department investigations into ex-Nazis living illegally in the United States. Gilman pledged to present the petitions to the appropriate officials and to further pursue the matter.

## Only 29 Jews Leave USSR In October

NEW YORK (WNS) — Only 29 Jews were granted exit visas from the Soviet Union in October, the lowest monthly Jewish emigration in more than 20 years, the National Conference on Soviet Jewry reported. The figure brings the total number of Soviet Jews permitted to emigrate during the first ten months of 1984 to 750.

Morris Abram, chairman of the Conference, said "This action by Soviet authorities, as exemplified by the latest figure, is cruel." He said the drastic curtailment of Soviet Jewish emigration

represents a "severe setback for those who are hopeful and sympathetic toward improved East-West relations." Abram added that the emigration decline "suggests a Soviet leadership perception which smacks of Stalinist paranoia and a narrow view of the world."

Herbert Kronish, chairman of the Greater New York Conference on Soviet Jewry, blamed Soviet leader Konstantin Chernenko for the sharp drop in October. He said that at the current rate of emigration, Soviet Jews would have to wait 250 years for their freedom.

LOS ANGELES (WNS) — Rabbi Marvin Hier, dean of the Simon Wiesenthal Center here, said that he is satisfied with the apology he had demanded from the publisher of the local German-language newspaper, Staats Zeitung, which described Mayor Edward Koch of New York as "Der Jude Koch" (The Jew Koch). The paper's publisher, in a printed front-page apology in his paper, admitted to "a very poor choice of words."
