## Jewish Woman Becomes Governor Of Vermont

NEW YORK (WNS) - Vermont, became the Madelein Kunin, the State's Democratic candidate in

first Jewish woman Governor, defeating State Attorney General John Easton Jr., a Republican. With 100 percent of the votes tallied, Kunin had 116,575 or 50.8 percent to Easton's 112,883 or 49.0 percent. Easton has conceded defeat.

Kunin is from a family of European emigrants that fled the Nazis in 1940 for the United States. The Swiss-born Kunin became a U.S. citizen in 1947. In 1972, she was elected to the Vermont House of Repre-

paigned against Easton mainly stressing the themes of experience improving and educational opportunities. Easton, 41. stressed the issues of law-and-order throughout the campaign. Kunin becomes only the second women governor in the U.S. and is only the third Democrat, to hold the office in Vermont in 130 years.

In Missouri, meanwhile, Democratic State Senator Harriet Woods, became the first woman elected to be Lt. Governor, defeating Republican Mel Hancock. Woods, who is Jewish, gained national prominence when she staged an unsuccessful bid to oust U.S. Senator John Danforth two years ago. With nearly 80 percent of the vote counted. Woods has 932,414 or 54 percent, to Hancock's 793,349, or 46 percent.
