Stolen IDF Property Worth \$3 Million Returned

TEL AVIV (WNS) -Stolen army property amounting to a virtual weapons arsenal valued at about \$3 million was returned to the Israel last Defense Force November. The IDF had declared November a "month of grace" during which citizens could return illegally obtained equipment to military bases or police stations without questioning or

risk of punishment.

According to the IDF, the grace period yielded 670 Soviet-made Kalachnikov assault rifles, a favorite weapon of the Palestine Liberation Organization, and other terrorist groups, large numbers of which were captured during the war in Lebanon.

European Anti-Semitism Still Thrives, Although Incidents Have Lessened


LONDON (WNS) -Anti-Semitism Europe nearly 40 years after the defeat of Hitler, was examined by representatives of nine European Jewish communities at a daylong session under the auspices of Committee on Anti-Semitism of the

World Jewish Congress.

The sober assessment was that anti-Semitism exists to a degree that demands constant vigilance and preven measures. tive discussions, and all specialists in the field agreed that the anti-Semitic pressures which European Jews have felt in recent years, has lessened somewhat.

They noted that the strength of neo-Nazi type organizations has not increased and the number of anti-Semitic incidents has declined But it takes only a few extremists to commit acts of terror and vandalism and therefore measures security must be kept fully operative, the easieris concluded.
