Kiev Refusenik Gets 4-Year Jail Term

NEW YORK (WNS) refusnik Josif Kiev Berenshtein, charged with allegedly "resisting arrest," was convicted and sentenced to years imprisonfour ment, the National Conference on Soviet Jewry learned here. The maximum penalty for the charge is five years. Berenshtein, a 47-yearengineer, old was arrested while in nearby Novograd Vilinsky to answer allegations of economic crimes made against his aunt, which have since been dropped.

The NCSJ's Lawyer's Committee noted that the warrant for this arrest left questions concerning the legality of the procedure, as well as the initial grounds for his arrest. Since his arrest Berenshtein's wife, Fania, and his daughter have been threatened with similar action.

Robert F. Slatzer, for 16 years a close friend of Marilyn Monroe and, for a brief interlude, her husband, came to see LEGENDS IN CONCERT at the Imperial Palace. He liked the entire show so much he sat through it twice, then returned to his room and watched the closed circuit TV "promo" for it several times.

"Susan has a remarkable likeness to Marilyn," he said. "She has the same stance and charisma. And she has a certain softness, a subtle way of being sexy." He was equally charmed by Susan's off-stage similarity to "MM."

Bob Slatzer met Marilyn in 1946 when she was a young brunette model with dreams of becoming an actress. Her name then was Norma Jeane Mortenson Dougherty. They remained close friends for the next 16 years, part of which he was preparing a draft of her authorized biography. Their brief marriage took place in 1952 before her highly publicized marriage to Joe DiMaggio. Slatzer saw Marilyn frequently in the weeks before her sudden death, even talking to her long distance less than 24 hours before she died.
