

## Chaos In Lebanon Predicted

TEL AVIV (WNS) -Brigadier-General Amos Gilboa, head of the Israeli delegation to the Israeli-Lebanon military chaos foresees Lebanon if Israel is forced decide unilateral withdrawal from Lebanon without satisfactory arrangements being made in advance to ensure security. He says that in that event Syria will be forced to step in to prevent chaos. Damascus will not take any steps which could lead to any political advantages to Israel as a result of the Lebanon War.

Gilboa told Israel Radio December 21 that if such a unilateral withdrawal is made, the Druze will take action to seize control of the Christian areas, especially those along the coast below their Kharoub mountains region. They would also probably try to seize Sidon port.

The Shiite Amal military organization would move to take control of southern Lebanon, and there would likely be fighting between the various Shiite Moslem factions.

Gilboa thinks the PLO would also try to return to the southern area abutting Israel.

He was pessimistic about Syria's chances of using the Christmas and New Year's recess to bring about some form of stability in Lebanon.

United **Nations** Secretary General Javier Perez de Cuellar is reported to have told Israel's Ambassador to the U.N. Binyamin Netanyahu that he would try and use the end-of-year recess to persuade the Lebanese government to get the Nakura talks restarted and back on the right road to agreement.

Natanyahu reportedly told him that if the talks fail, the IDF would have to effect a redisposition in Lebanon.
