

JERUSALEM (WNS) — Following two days of intensive debate, the Cabinet voted 16-6 to approve a three stage withdrawal of the Israel Defense Force from south Lebanon.

The plan, proposed by Defense Minister Yitzhak Rabin and strongly supported by Premier Shimon Peres, is a unilateral measure in the absence of a military security and withdrawal agreement with Lebanon, although Israel and Lebanon are expected to continue their negotiations at Nakura for the time being.

In the first stage, to be completed within five weeks, the IDF will pull back from the Awali River (Continued on page 11)
