Selections, say the editors, are mostly subjective, "based on size, scope, balance, quality, ambiance, or some intangible we can't fully explain." All the collections honored are open to the public.

From more than 100 car museums in the U.S. and 160 in Europe, CAR AND DRIVER singled out six European collections and four American collections (including the Imperial Palace) as the

"In just a few years," according to the article, "Ralph Engelstad has built his collection to more than 350 automobiles, and 200 of them are displayed in 60,000 square feet of floor space."

The article mentions the oldest car in the collection, an 1897 Haynes-Apperson, and a few of the cars which belonged to famous persons such as Mrs. Henry Ford, Eleanor Roosevelt, Al Capone, Howard Hughes, and Adolf Hitler. "American cars are predominant, but there are some rather fine examples by foreign builders."

The Hilton's instructional program has been widely received by casino patrons because it gives them a basic understanding of the various games and by doing this, it has helped to increase their chances of winning.


Chevrolet's Traveling Pro Football Hall Of Fame Exhibits At The **Boulevard Mall**
