

## Las Vegas Synagogues Present Adult Education Program In February And March

LAS VEGAS — Las Vegas' synagogues will join together to present an adult education program in February and March. This is the first time a combined program will be attempted in Southern Nevada.

Sponsoring organizations include Temple Beth Sholom, Congregation Ner Tamid, Temple Beth Am and the Hebrew Academy, but membership in any of these organizations is not required for persons to attend. The February 14 and 21 sessions will be at Temple Beth Sholom, while the February 28 and March 7 classes will be conducted at Congregation Ner Tamid.

The courses offered will include: Contemporary Jewish Thought in the Post Holocaust Era; the First Century of the Common Era; The Synoptic Gospels; Jewish Music; Current Moral and Social Issues and The Jewish Family.
