

## Hungary Issues Jewish Stamps

BUDAPEST (WNS) making the first appearance of stamps on postage stamps featuring objects contained in the Hungarian Jewish Museum, reported.

Seven stamps comprise the series to be issued by the post office under the title of "Jewish Art in Hungary," according to the WJC. The announcement by Hungarian authorities said the stamps would "depict the most beautiful items of the Hungarian Jewish Museum."

The announcement coincided with a wreath-laying ceremony at the memorial wall in the cemetery next to the Dohany Street synagogue commemorating the 40th anniversary of the liberation of the Budapest Ghetto. It was attended by "representatives of the State Office for Church Affairs, other state party and social organizations, and representatives of the Soviet Embassy in Budapest, according to a Radio Budapest report.

may significantly have altered the shape of the world and lead to the Balkanization of the Middle East, Ms. Kirkpatrick devoted the greater part of her exposition to the peril which the Soviet-dominated PLO poses to the region.

Referring to the "decades since the establishment of Israel," and noting that the Palestine issue has undergone subtle changes, she charged that "a myth has been built on the foundation of the genuine problem of the Palestinian refugees: the myth," she emphasized, "has developed the extraordinary belief that only the presence of Israel stands in the way of achieving Arab unity and integration and peace and stability in the Middle East.

"This is patently false," she insists. "In this Arab world where faith and politics are linked, traditionalists and radicals, Saudis and Libyans can unite in hostility against Israel - whose right to exist they deny, whose very existence they refuse to acknowledge, whose name they refuse to utter, calling Israel instead 'the Zionist entity' or the 'deformed Zionist entity'."

Jeane Kirkpatrick is admired and respected by all segments within the American community. Both Republicans and Democrats will be keeping a close eye on her as she returns to her academic career. It must not be forgotten that General Dwight D. Eisenhower found his road to The White House via an academic institution - Columbia University.
