West Coast Trials For Maccabiah Games

Trials for five of the teams which will make up the United States contingent in the World Maccabiah Games, will be held in the Los Angeles area during the next two months, according to Leonard Reifman and Joseph Siegman, both of Los Angeles. They are vice-presidents of the United States Maccabiah Committee, which sponsors the American team for the quadriennial sports festival. Known as the "Jewish Olympics," they are held every fourth year, in the summer following the Olympics, in Israel.

Contact person for all five tryout events is Eli Sherman, athletic director at the Westside Jewish Community Center, who was captain of the gold medal basketball team in the 1957 Games.

Soccer trials are scheduled for Saturday evening and Sunday, March 2 and 3, at a site in Los Angeles County. Eli Marmur, president of the Maccabee Soccer Club, a perennial championship contender on the national scene, is west coast chairman of the national soccer committee.

Men's basketball trials will be held on Saturday evening and Sunday, April 13 and 14. Women's tryouts are scheduled for Saturday evening and Sunday, April 20 and 21. Men's and women's volleyball trials for west coast candidates will be held early in May.

The national coaches for all teams will be on hand during the tryouts for their sports, according to Sherman. Similar procedures were in force for the recent west coast trials in tennis, softball

and water polo.

Brandt Says Reagan Should Go To Dachau During Visit To West Germany

TEL AVIV (WNS) — Former West German Chancellor Willy Brandt said here that "it would have been a good idea" had President Reagan decided to include a visit to Dachau when he attends an economic summit meeting in Bonn next May 2-4.

"I hope he did not get advice from any official quarters in Germany that this would not be a good idea," Brandt told reporters, after a ceremony at which the Jewish National Fund presented him with a 70th birthday present -- a forest in his name to be planted in lower Galilee.

The White House has informed Bonn that the President would not be visiting Dachau, site of one of the most notorious concentration camps of the Nazi era, because he "doesn't think it is the appropriate thing to do."

The West German government reportedly had suggested such a visit as part of the commemoration of the 40th anniversary of the Allied victory over Nazi Germany on May 8. Reagan was quoted in the American media as saying Dachau represented a past of which the people of today's Germany had no part.

Dole told the audience that the United States is now in "close touch" with Israel to arrange an economic aid program. He expects the Administration, he said, to seek "supplemental" emergency assistance for fiscal 1985 in addition to a boost in military aid. For fiscal 1986, he added that he anticipates a level of assistance "at or above" the 1985 figure of 1.2 billion dollars.

While stressing the need to provide assistance for Israel, Dole said, however, that the U.S. "can provide emergency and ongoing assistance only if the Israelis take decisive steps to put their own economic house in order." He added that "by all accounts the Israel Government understands and agrees to that central point."

Dole asserted that America's ability to aid its friends and allies -- "particularly Israel" -- is based on preserving its economic strength which, in turn, is dependent on reducing the U.S. budgetary deficit.
