



## Israel Will Aid In U.S. Probe For Mengele

JERUSALEM (WNS) The United States and Israel are preparing cooperate in the to search for Josef Mengele, the Auschwitz death camp doctor the who is most notorious Nazi war criminal still at large.

The U.S. Department of Justice said that it would accept evidence from Israelis in the investigation just ordered by Attorney General William French Smith into the whereabouts of Mengele and of reports that in 1947 he was arrested and released by American authorities in Vienna.

Neal Sher, chief of Justice Departthe ment's Office Special Investigations (OSI), told a Voice of Israel Radio reporter in Washington that the investigation will be carried out in coorother dination with governments. He would not say whether U.S. agents would participate in the search for the war criminal.

It was learned. that meanwhile, Minister Justice Nissim has Moshe established an interministerial headquarcoordinate ters to government activities to track down Mengele. inter-ministerial The group will consist of representatives of the Justice Ministry, Foreign Ministry, police and other government agencies. Nissim said all legal preparatiaons have been completed

to bring Mengele to swift trial in Israel once he is found and captured.

Details of Mengele's brutal medical experiments on Auschwitz inmates were recounted in detail by survivors attending an international congress at the Yad Vashem to mark the 40th anniversary of the liberation of the death camp. The three-day gathering is credited with arousing world-wide interest in bringing Mengele to justice.
