

Australian Race Driver Visits Imperial Palace Auto Collection

Australian race driver GREGG HANSFORD and a coterie of journalists from "down under" were given a V.I.P. tour of the Imperial Palace Auto Collection recently. They were first taken through the Collection which houses more than 200 antique, classic and vintage autos on the fifth floor of the hotel's parking facility and then toured the Restoration Shop where approximately 150 vehicles are stored.

Hansford had just completed in the "Daytona 24 Hour" in Florida and was traveling across the U.S. before returning to Australia. In Daytona, he was part of a team of four drivers for Mazda of Australia. Hansford shared the wheel of a Mazda RX7 in the GTO class with Allan Moffat (lead driver), Peter McLeod, and Kevin Bartlett. They were running in second place when a gear failure forced them to stop for repairs. The pit crew rebuilt the engine in four hours and the team finished in seventh place.

Hansford is a former world champion motorcyclist. Asked how many countries he had competed in as a cyclist, he replied, "Thirty-one. Oh -- and Tasmania. That made thirty-two!"

Serious motorcycle competition is centered in Europe, causing Gregg to be away from Australia eight months of the year. His wish to travel less was what led him to race car driving instead. He now takes two to four week jaunts to races and can return to his home.

He was very impressed with many vehicles in the Collection, but especially with the fine motorcycles. He posed for photos on a 1941 Harley Davidson once owned by Clark Gable. He also posed in a 1950 Crosley race car so small he could barely squeeze in his long legs.

The Imperial Palace Auto Collection is open daily from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m.

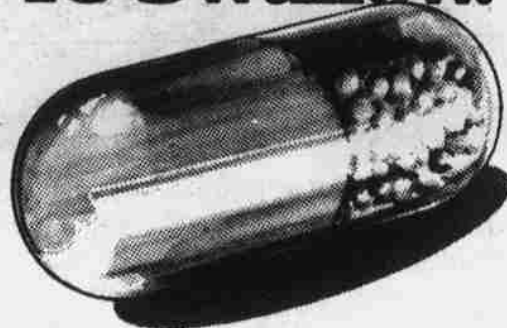
