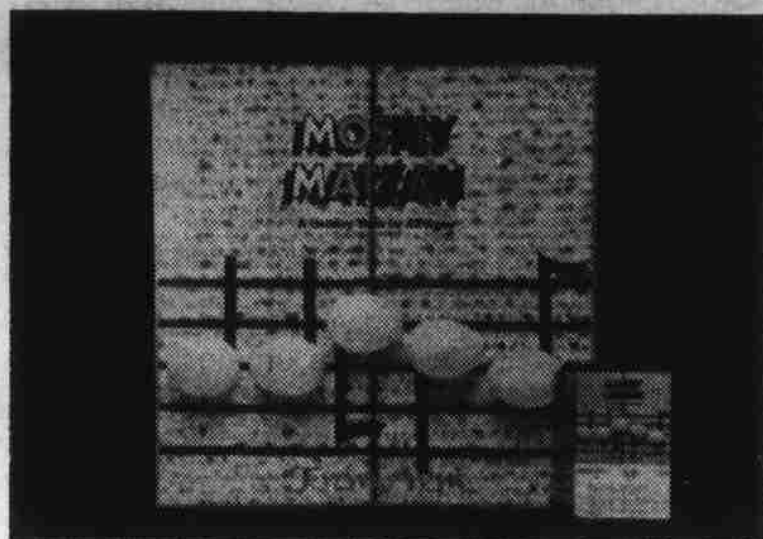


## Board Of Jewish Education Offers Special Holiday Items For Passover

These items and more can be found at the Board of Jewish Education of Greater New York. BJE offers educational materials for children and gifts for adults, and accepts orders from anywhere in the United States and Canada.

For a historical background on Passover, "Mostly Matzah," on record or cassette, brings to life the ancient story of Passover and its contemporary celebration in terms children can easily understand and enjoy. The record includes such favorite songs as "Ma Nishtanah" and "Dayenu" in Hebrew, and is available for \$7.95.

For families unfamiliar with all the melodies sung during the Seder, "Seder Melodies," begins with the candle lighting and presents the songs of the entire Seder meal, ending with the concluding Seder song, "Had Gadya." The package includes lyrics in Hebrew with English translation, for \$9.00.

The BJE also offers holiday videos, among them "Ha-Afikomen," an animated film which takes you into the home of a family as they prepare for and participate in the Passover Seder. The film includes the blessings over the candles and the matzah, the Four Questions and Passover songs. Cost for video and guide is \$49.50.

For unique Passover gifts, the Speyer Haggadah and the Leipnik Haggadah are sure to enhance any Passover Seder. Both are illuminated reproductions of original 18th century Haggadot and include text in Hebrew and English. The Speyer's Haggadah accompanying booklet offers a full description of the haggadah and background information on the history of haggadot. Both are collector's items and are available for \$49.95 each.

Other gift items include illuminated old Jewish manuscripts, for \$10.00, framed or matted, holiday posters, children's books, and audiovisual materials.
