

PLO Spokesman: Mubarak's Peace Initiative 'Totally Unacceptable'

BONN (WN S) — The Israel, constituted a peace initiative of surrender to the President Hosni Mubarak of Egypt is totally unacceptable for the Palestine Liberation Organization, a prominent spokesman for the PLO, Abu Iyad, told the West German mass circulation weekly, Der Spiegel. In an interview, Abu Iyad stated that Mubarak's ideas of a Jordanian delegation "with several Palestinians" to eventual negotiations with

Israel, constituted a surrender to the Americans and the Israelis. He insisted that Arafat personally rejects the initiative and said there was no room for hopes that the PLO would change this attitude.

Abu Iyad is a top aide to Arafat. He is widely known as the leader of the "Black September" Palestinian revolt in Jordan and as the man who initiated contacts of the PLO with various European

terrorist groups, including the West German Red Army terrorist group.

Reagan Urged To Visit Concentration Camp

NEW YORK (WNS) — The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith urged President Reagan to visit a concentration camp site when he attends the annual Economic Summit in Bonn in May.

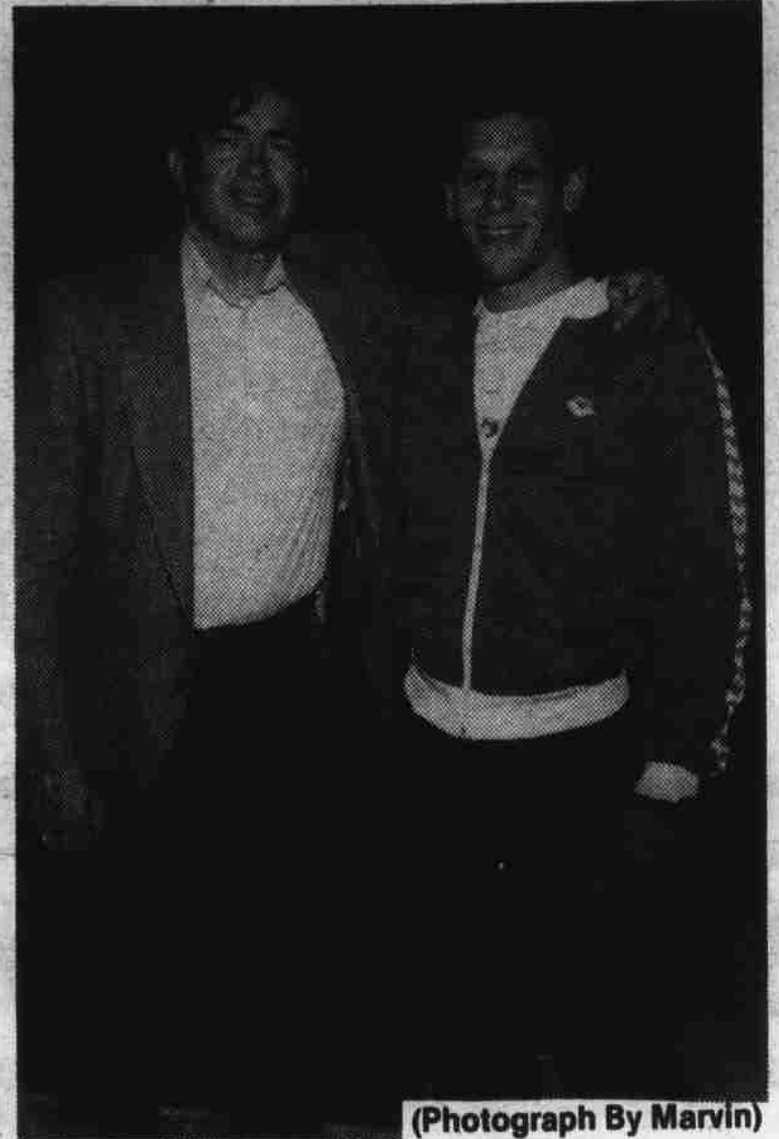
The appeal followed remarks by an unnamed senior Administration official to a group of reporters explaining why the President would not visit a concentration camp. He was quoted

as saying: "There are other horrors. We don't celebrate massacres of Indians, which we perpetrated ourselves, and we should remember that. But we quickly bury that in our conscience."

"I'm not condoning what the Germans did or anything else, but what we're saying is we're over there for an Economic summit." He continued:

"Look, it's 40 years ago. We all recognize what has happened. Most of the people in Germany today were not even alive when this happened. It's an atrocity. The German people understand this. They know it. It's regrettable. We can never bring back the dead...Isn't it time we went forward from here, honoring our dead, remembering what happened, but not constantly bringing it up?"

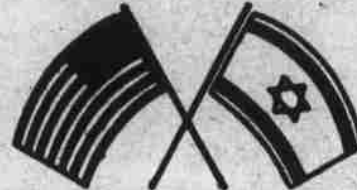
