NEW YORK (WNS) — Astronaut Jeffrey Hoffman, a crew member aboard the current fiveday mission of space shuttle Discovery, is carrying on his personal flight kit four mezuzahs and two atarot, the inscription on the colar of a tallit.

The 40-year-old Hoffman, of Clear Lake City, Texas, a suburb of Houston, is the first Jewish male astronaut to go into space. Judith Resnik was the first Jewish woman to go into space when she was a crew member last June aboard the shuttle Discovery, Hoffman, an astro-physicist, plans to present the glass mezuzah to the Israel Museum. One of the ceramic ones will go to the Jewish Museum in New York, another to Congregation Shaar Hasholom in Houston and the fourth he will keep for personal use.
