

Reno Temple Needs Rabbi

Madge Tillim, President of Temple Emanu-El, the only Conservative Jewish Synagogue in Northern Nevada, reports that the congregation is seeking a Rabbi. "The community, containing approximately 1,500 Jews of which nearly 200 are a part of the Temple, is ripe for a dynamic, dedicated and creative Rabbi who can lead the congregation in a community of rapid growth which is ripe for a great expansion of its Jewish religious and cultural facilities," said Tillim.

"One manifestation of that growth," continued Tillim, "is the fact that the Temple has secured most of the funds needed to construct a Judaica library designed to be affiliated with the University of Nevada and to serve the entire State of Nevada and to be located on the grounds of Temple Emanu-El.

Tillim, the first woman President in the 50 year history of the Temple, also indicated that teaching positions for the Rabbi would be available at the University of Nevada at Reno or at the area's junior educational facility, Truckee Community College. Reno, she noted, is the center of a new upsurge in cultural development with an expanded Opera, Symphony and a whole array of theater groups. The city, she concluded,

Canada Urged To Extradite Dutch Nazi Collaborator

TORONTO (WNS) — The Netherlands government has asked Canada to amend an 86-year-old treaty between the two countries which has frustrated efforts to obtain the extradition of Joap Luitjens, a resident of Vancouver, who was convicted in his native Holland in 1948 of collaboration with the Nazi occupation forces during World War II.

Luitjens was sentenced in absentia to 20 years in prison for

"aiding and abetting" the enemy, a crime not covered by the Canada-Netherlands treaty of 1899. He was found guilty of helping the Nazis track down Dutch resistance fighters and locating secret radio transmitters and receivers. He is also alleged to have killed a German army deserter and a Dutch resistance member. Luitjens has denied killing anyone but refused to go to Holland to answer the charges.

AJCongress Director Says President's Visit To Nazi Military Cemetery Is 'Repugnant'

Henry Siegman, executive director of the American Jewish Congress issued the following statement concerning President Reagan's visit to the Bitburg cemetery in his visit to Germany:

We are pleased that President Reagan has reversed his earlier decision not to visit a concentration camp during his visit to Germany. However, we reject the notion that a visit to a Holocaust site somehow makes the President's visit to the Bitburg military cemetery more acceptable. The President's participation in a commemoration at a cemetery in which are buried the very people who ran the concentration camps and committed the worst atrocities against American soldiers remains as repugnant as it was before.

We understand Mr. Reagan's desire not to offend today's Germany. Neither do we. But if it is true that leaders of today's Germany would be offended by the President's failure to pay homage to fallen members of the Nazi SS, then perhaps it may be necessary to reassess the assumptions we have made about the new Germany.

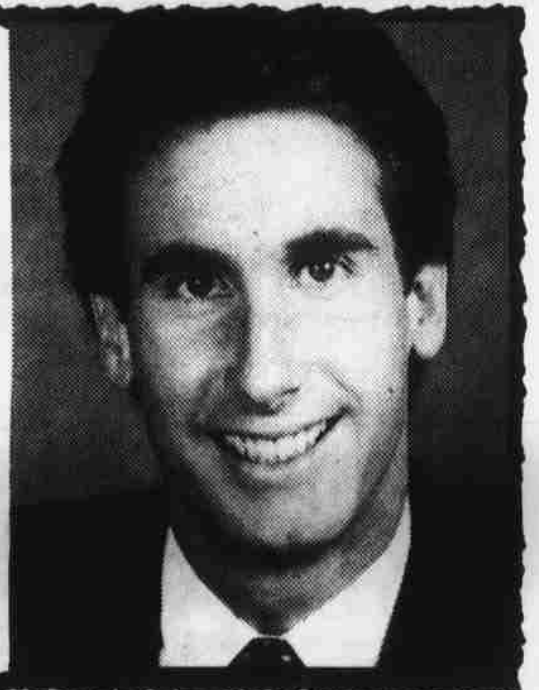
