AJCongress Director Says President's Visit To Nazi Military Cemetery Is 'Repugnant'

Henry Siegman, executive director of the American Jewish Congress issued the following statement concerning President Reagan's visit to the Bitburg cemetery in his visit to Germany:

We are pleased that President Reagan has reversed his earlier decision not to visit a concentration camp during his visit to Germany. However, we reject the notion that a visit to a Holocaust site somehow makes the President's visit to the Bitburg military cemetery more acceptable. 
