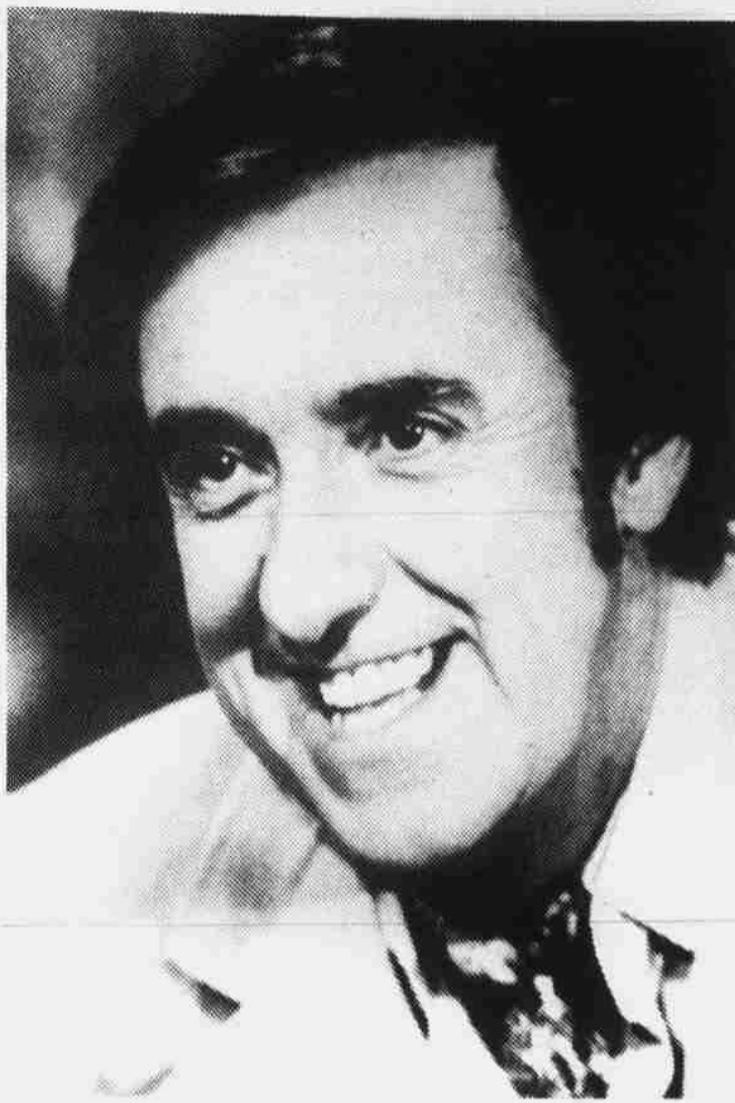


Lonnie Shorr And Jim Nabors Star In "Bal du Moulin Rouge"
