At the doorway, Lou Teitelbaum affixed the mazzuzah. Inside, Harold Walt, Baal Tefilla from Los Angeles, led the ceremonial Hakafot, traditional parading of the Torahs around the Bima. After the Torahs were put in the ark, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Sass turned on the new Ner Tamid.

"We must continue to maintain the link of Torah-Judaism from one generation to the next," said Jack Super, President, in his remarks to the standing-room only crowd.

After the dedication, a luncheon catered by Shoshana's Kosher Catering was served. Congregation Shaarei Tefilla holds daily morning services at 7:30 a.m., Friday night at sundown, Shabbat at 8:30 a.m. and Sunday at 9:00 a.m.
