GEORGE TRULLINGER has always belonged in the music business. "I love music and I love to perform. This has always gotten me through the low moments in life."

A native of Huntington Beach, California.

George worked several jobs including three years as a wild 'n crazy guide on the Jungle Cruise at Disneyland.

"I worked Disneyland during the day and played gigs with my band at night. I knew I wanted to play rock 'n roll full time. I answered an audition call for a traveling rock show featuring the Beatles and I got the part of 'Paul McCartney.' I quit my job and spent the next two years playing in Canada, Lake Tahoe and Chicago as well as clubs in Southern California - paying dues. Life on the road was hectic at best, like the night I first did Buddy Holly. The guitar player who regularly did Holly got sick two hours before the show. I went on in his place because I was the only one who fit the costume! Then I discovered I liked it so well, I began perfecting my look and sound as Buddy."

That's when George met Producer John Stuart who was looking for a Buddy Holly lookalike/soundalike for his new Las Vegas production, LEGENDS IN CONCERT.

"I've been working with LEGENDS IN CONCERT since the opening on May 5, 1983, and it's been a fantastic experience for me. I've got the best of two worlds here. I get the thrill and satisfaction of performing every night in a hit Las Vegas show and I have free time to write my own music and work on other projects. Doing Buddy Holly has allowed me to travel and meet some wonderful people that I wouldn't have met any other way."

Will he ever tire of performing the rock 'n roll classics of Buddy Holly?

"Get tired of doing Buddy? That'll be the day!" LEGENDS IN CONCERT is presented in the Imperial Theatre nightly (except Sundays) at 8:00 and 11:00 p.m. Show is priced at \$11.95 which includes two cocktails.

West German President Assails German Indifference To Nazism

BONN (WNS) — The President of the Federal Republic, Richard Von Weizsaecker, has sharply criticized the indifference of the German public, including his own generation, to the unprecedent crimes committed by the Nazis against European Jews.

He said many more Germans had knowledge of the sufferings of the Jews than were willing to admit it after the end of World War II. Weizsaecker made his remarks in an address to a joint session of the two houses of the West German Parliament -- the Bundestag and Bundesrat -- in what was seen as an attempt to ease the pain caused Jews here and abroad by the visit of President Reagan and Chancellor Helmut Kohl to the military cemetery at Bitburg May 5 where members of the Waffen SS are buried along with other German war dead.

Weizsaecker, who is said to have been personally troubled by Kohl's insistence that Reagan visit Bitburg, described the 40th anniversary of the end of World War II in Europe as a day both of liberation from Nazi terror and mourning for the millions who perished in death camps.
