The hit show LEGENDS IN CONCERT is heading into its third year at the Imperial Palace in Las Vegas. The show, which features live recreations of legendary superstars with dazzling special effects, opened at the Imperial Palace May 5, 1983. Jack Benny serves as master of ceremonies, tieing together the presentation.

Four dancers enliven the Buddy Holly, Marilyn Monroe and Judy Garland segments. In the Garland segment, clowns and showgirls highlight Judy's song "That Entertainment."

Changes have been made in the multi-media presentations which introduce the stars and their eras. The objective is always to create in the audience a sense of deja vu, a feeling that they are seeing those legendary superstars perform live.

To his already impressive array of lasers, Stuart has added a 20 watt krypton laser. He has also added red Tivoli lights and is having the set pieces and orchestra front re-designed.

The best thing about LEGENDS, though, is the talent and energy of the young artists on stage. After working together for two years, Stuart says the cast, orchestra and back up singers are like a family, all pulling together to make LEGENDS better than ever.

Being constructed outside the showroom is a "LEGENDS Hall of Fame" featuring photos of current stars of the show. Coming soon is a colorful souvenir program with pictures and information on all the stars.




WASHINGTON (WNS) — The House approved by a 422-0 vote the bill establishing a Free Trade Area between Israel and the U.S. The bill, which would eliminate tariffs and other trade barriers, in phases over a 10-year period, was also approved unanimously by the Senate Finance Committee.
