Where There's Smokey...At Caesars

Recording star Smokey Robinson returns to the Caesars Palace Circus Maximus Showroom through June 17.

Robinson brings his Motown Magic to the showroom spotlight after his recent appearance on the television special "Motown Returns to the Apollo." He also is considering doing a summer replacement series for NBC. When he's not singing or composing, Smokey mans a desk as a vice president for Motown, a company he helped to build.

It was, after all, Smokey's teenaged group, the Miracles, that performed the company's debut single, "Get a Job." And the group's catchy "Shop Around" is credited with christening Motown as a force in popular music.

As a songwriter and vocalist, Smokey led the Miracles through more than a decade of top 10 hits. Sings like "You Really Got a Hold on Me" and "Satisfaction" dominated the charts. In addition, he wrote and produced records for labelmates

the Temptations, Mary Wells and Marvin Gaye.

Since accepting executive duty with the company, Smokey has found time for a solo career, with eight albums to date including such hits as "Baby Come Close" and "Cruisin."
