LYNDA CARTER eased down from Reno for her Desert Inn run with the BROTHERS SMOTHERS through July 17...Bagman MURRAY

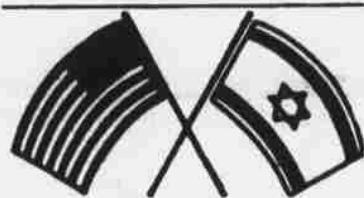
