

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON (WNS) — Ambassador Stanislav Suja of Czechoslovakia has been asked to intervene with Czech officials to assure the preservation of Jewish cemeteries in Czechoslovakia, according to Rabbi Moshe Sherer, president of Agudath Israel of America. The appeal was made to Suja by a Jewish delegation which met with the envoy in the Czech embassy.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — I. L. Kenen, the founder of the America-Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) was honored here last week with a grove planted in his name in the U.S. Independence Forest near Jerusalem. Jewish National Fund chairman Moshe Rivlin and JNF U.S. President Charlotte Jacobson were among the many guests at the ceremony, which marked Kenen's 80th birthday.

WASHINGTON (WNS) — Some 150 Jewish youths -- teenagers who recently came of bar and bat mitzvah age -- demonstrated in support of Soviet Jewry, first outside the National Press Building and then at the Soviet Embassy where they joined in the regularly scheduled daily Soviet Jewry vigil there.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — An eight-year-old boy was badly injured when an explosive charge went off near a bus stop in a Jerusalem suburb. He was identified as Alan Hananya. The incident occurred in Neve Yacov, the northernmost part of the post-1967 new Jewish suburbs ringing the capital. Police said the bomb was hidden in rocks near the bus stop.

NEW YORK (WNS) — The National Conference on Soviet Jewry reported that 36 Soviet Jews had been permitted to emigrate during June, one of the lowest totals in recent months.



BRUSSELS (WNS) — The first synagogue at any European airport was dedicated by the Minister of Communications, Herman de Croo, who said it symbolized Belgium's respect for freedom of religion, especially at an airport which is a crossroads of people of all faiths. The 50 seat synagogue is located in the main terminal near the Catholic and Protestant chapels.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — A three-years research grant from the U.S. National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has been given to Prof. Amos Ranin of the Department of Soil and Water Sciences at the Hebrew University's faculty of agriculture in Rehovot. His task is to carry out research into various types of soil on earth that could serve as a model for soils on the planet Mars. The research is connected with a planned U.S. space probe to Mars in 1990.

NEW YORK (WNS) — With the approval of the government of Czechoslovakia, 2,000 copies of a one volume edition of the Torah -- the first five books of the Jewish Bible -- in Czech and Hebrew have been printed in New York and shipped to Prague as a gift to the Czech Jewish community by the Appeal of Conscience Foundation. Foundation president Rabbi Arthur Schneier announced that the 356-page hardcover book is the first of its kind to be published since the 1930s and fills an important need for the Czech Jewish community.

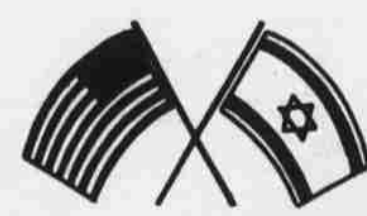
