DIA. Entry will be free. Tokens obtained from bill changers or cashiers will be used to operate most of the center's attractions. Daily operating hours will be from 10 A.M. until late at night.

The large arcade, snack bar, Lil' Indy Raceway, and 18 hole miniature golf course will open on August 27th in preparation for the labor day weekend. A second 18 hole miniature golf course will be completed in October and a third one next summer. A giant baseball court will open before the end of 1985. It will utilize 18 computer controlled, variable speed, hardball and softball pitching machines. A beautiful pond featuring delightful "waterbugs" (a boat reminiscent of the old bumper car) will be completed before next summer.

Financing for the project was provided by Valley Bank of Nevada. Contractor for the central building is Cooke and Kerzetski Company of Las Vegas. The remainder of the unique facility is being constructed by the company's own crew under the direction of Dan Madsen, one of the owners. While overseeing the erection of a thirty foot tall castle designed to hit golf balls through, Dan said, "You have got to be crazy to be in this business, but we love it."

Salvation Army's First Convention In Israel



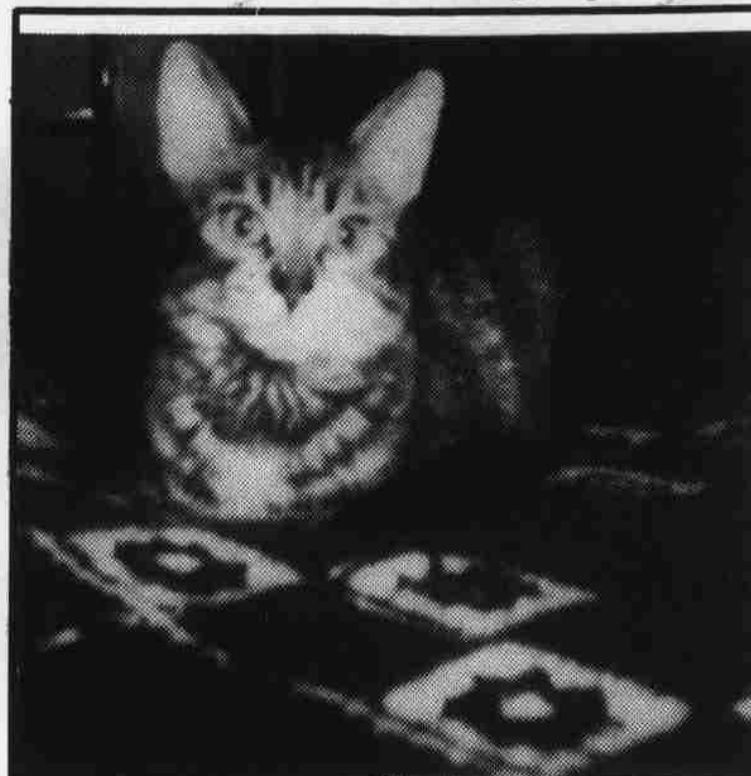

Maureen Reagan Reports On Nairobi Women's Conference

WASHINGTON (WNS) — West European delegates at the recently

concluded United Nations End of the Decade Women's Conference held in Nairobi, Kenya, failed to provide strong public support against including an attack on Israel and Zionism in the final forward looking strategies document adopted by the conference, the head of the U.S. delegation charged.

Maureen Reagan, President Reagan's daughter, however, added that it was the support of the Western and Latin American delegations that finally led to the exclusion of any condemnation of Israel in the final document, having decided that "enough is enough."

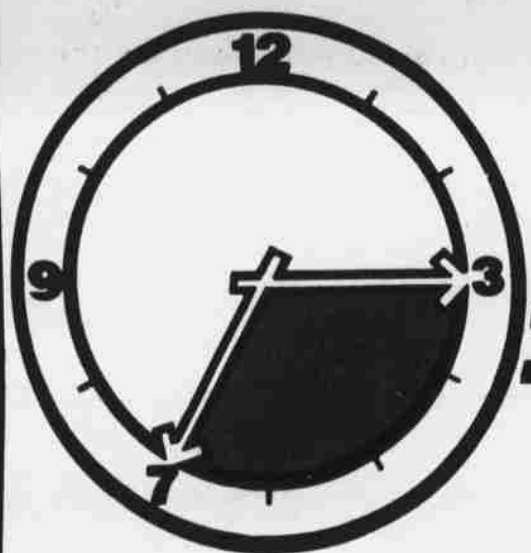

- Upgrade attic insulation to a recommended level of R-30.
- Replace old air conditioners with high efficiency heat pumps.
