Las Vegas Hilton Pays \$112,096 On Keno Ticket

A Southern California man, who preferred not to be identified, pulled together the right combination of numbers on a keno ticket to win \$112,096 at the Las Vegas Hilton late Wednesday morning.

According to George Terrio, keno manager, the \$112,096 was the largest amount ever paid on a progressive 8-spot at the Las Vegas Hilton.

A world record was set at the resort in July, 1983, when Johan Lund was paid \$110,000. Since the inception of the progressive keno program, the Las Vegas Hilton has paid-out over \$552,000 on progressive 8-spots alone.
