Dresden Philharmonic Opens Master Series At UNLV

UNLV's 10th Master Series season opens Oct. 18 with a performance by the 115-year-old Dresden Philharmonic under the baton of Maestro Rolf Reuter, with famed American piano soloist Agustin Anievas.

According to Dr. Charles Vanda, director of UNLV's Performing Arts Center, limited subscriptions for the 1985 season are still available. For ticket information, call 739-3535.

The Dresden Philharmonic, which made its American debut in 1909 with 56 concerts in 30 states, has a rich history that includes association with a variety of musical greats, including Brahms, Strauss, Tchaikovsky, and Rachmaninoff.

Maestro Reuter has held posts as chief conductor and music director of Komische Opera of Berlin and music director of Germany's National Theater in Weimar. In addition, he has led numerous productions, including "Tosca," "Prince Igor," and "Othello." He has recently appeared as a guest conductor in Italy, Russia and Great


Anievas, an American pianist of Spanish-Mexican descent, was introduced to piano at age 3 by his mother. After proving exceptional ability at a number of early recitals, Anievas made his orchestral debut at 18 as a soloist with New York's Little Orchestra.

In 1961, Anievas won acclaim as the recipient of first prize in the First International Dimitri Mitropoulos Music Competition. His previous awards include the Concert Artists' Guild New York Debut Award, the Michael's Award in Chicago, and other international competition awards.

The concert program for the Dresden Philharmonic has not yet been announced.

The remainder of the 10th anniversary season of the Master Series will feature the Orchestra du Capitole de Toulouse on Nov. 7; the Prague Chamber Orchestra on Jan. 14, 1986; the Philharmonia Hungarica on Feb. 19; the Utah Symphony, March 5; the Vienna Chamber Orchestra on March 18; the Soviet Emigre Orchestra on April 23, and the season finale, May 22, the Philadelphia Orchestra with Riccardo Muti, music director.


