

AMSTERDAM (WNS) - Queen Beatrix of The Netherlands and Prince Consort Claus were the quests of honor at a synagogue service here celebrating the 350th anniversary of the Amsterdam Ashkenazic Congregation. The former Ashkenazic Chief Rabbi of Amsterdam, Aaron Schuster, who has been living in Jerusalem since his retirement, returned to preside.

The service was held at the Sephardic Esnoga synagogue because none of the Ashkenazic synagogues is large enough to accommodate all of the invited guests. Part

Season Subscription/Tickets At UNLV's Department Of Theatre Arts

Season subscriptions are still available for UNLV's Deparatment of Theatre Arts 1985-86 season that will include a broad range of dramatic works.

The DTA recently announced the season will include a performance of Shakespeare's "As You Like It" by John Houseman's The Acting Company on March 31. All season subscribers will receive tickets to that performance, however, a second play by The Acting Company, not yet announced, will not be included in the season package.

Season subscribers can save up to 25 percent off the full price for admission by purchasing their tickets in one of four packages:

-- Plan A; All seven plays, Friday or Saturday evening, \$44;

-- Plan B: All seven plays, Thursday evening or Sunday matinee, \$38;

- Plan C: Four Judy Bayley Theatre plays and "As You Like It," Friday or Saturday evening, \$37.50; or

-- Plan D: Four Judy Bayley Theatre plays and "As You Like It," Thursday evening or Sunday matinee, \$34.

Each plan provides season subscribers with guaranteed seating and ticket exchange privileges.

For those who do not buy a season subscription, limited tickets are available before each performance at the performing arts box office in the Artemus W. Ham Concert Hall.

Ticket discounts for DTA performances are offered to senior citizens, military personnel, and those 18 and under. UNLV students are admitted free to all DTA productions. Though these discounts are not available for performances by touring companies, partial discounts may be offered.
