Seasons tickets at \$55 for the 4 programs are still available. Tickets for Romeo and Juliet and the October program can be purchased at the box office between 12:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday and one hour before performances. Prices are \$15, \$10, \$6, children and senior citizens are \$10, \$7, \$5. Group rates are available for 20 or more. For information and reservations call 739-3801.

The Fourth Annual Imperial Palace Antique Auto Run will be the largest Auto Run yet, according to Kris Engelstad, co-ordinator of the popular Las Vegas event. The Auto Run is a three day event, October 25-27, for owners of cars built before 1937. Focus of the gathering is a drive through the desert and foothills of southern Nevada on Saturday, October 26.

"We received our 200th registration August first," Engelstad said, "and more arrive daily." The first Auto Run, in 1982, had 60 entrants, the second had 120, and last year's event had 237 autos. Registration for the 1985 Auto Run will be limited to 300 autos.

Most of the entrants are from central and southern California, several are from Colorado, Arizona and Nevada, and some from as far away as South Dakota and Wisconsin.

"Many of the names are very familiar to us," Engelstad says. "People come to the Auto Run once, have a terrific time, and they go back to Downey, Riverside, et cetera, and talk to their friends in the local antique auto clubs. The next year they all come together!"

The Auto Run begins Saturday morning, October 26th, in front of the hotel. The send-off is always a colorful, gala event and draws a large crowd of antique auto buffs. Mid-way on the run there will be a stop at Boulder Beach on Lake Mead for a lavish catered barbecue.

The oldest car entered so far is a 1906 Rambler Touring car owned by Dick Miller of Riverside, California. Miller is a "pioneer" of the Auto Run, having driven in all three previous events.
