The Institute will obtain contemporary art exhibitions of nations and internature stature for display on the campus with money raised from the private sector. Maxson has named UNLV Art Department chairman Tom Holder as director of the institute.

"Tom is an outstanding artist and administrator, and I have complete confidence in his ability to develop an art institute that Nevadans will be proud of," Maxson said.

Maxson added that local real estate developer Mark Fine will chair a community advisory board for the Institute.

"Mark Fine is one of Nevada's brightest young businessmen. He not only understands contemporary art, but he has a deep appreciation and love for the contemporary art form. He is the perfect man for the job."

Holder said he, too, is extremely enthusiastic

about the formation of the institute.

"There has been a great deal of interest at UNLV and throughout the community in creating a fine art museum on campus," Holder said. "The Institute can do many things that a museum can do in terms of procuring the kind of exhibits we would like to see on campus." He added that the UNLV Art Gallery will house most of the Institute's exhibitions and may eventually bear the Institute's name.

The advisory board, currently in the process of being formed, will be composed of representatives from some of the city's largest businesses and corporations, plus noted civic leaders.

The Institute will co-sponsor its first exhibit, "Disarming Images," with the Nevada State Council of the Arts. It is scheduled to appear in both the UNLV Art Gallery and the Museum of Natural History January 6 - February 2.
