
Don't Miss "Jubilee!" At The MGM

CBS To Televise Program On Jewish Education

NEW YORK -- A half-hour television program, filmed at the recent Tenth Annual Conference on Alternatives in Jewish Eduction, will be broadcast by the CBS-TV network on Sunday, Nov. 3, as part of the weekly series For Our Times.


To the best of our knowledge, this is one of the few times that a TV network has devoted a full program to the subject of Jewish education," said Eliot Spack, National Director of the Coalition for Alternatives in Jewish Education (CAJE), sponsor of the conference.

In New York City, station WCBS-TV will carry the program on Nov. 3 at 8:30 a.m. Other CBS-TV stations around the country may show it on other days, at other times, or not show it at all. Because each local station has these options, Jewish Federations, Community Relations Councils, Boards of Jewish Education, synagogues, and other groups concerned with religious education are being urged to contact their local CBS-TV station to express their interest in seeing the program.

"We hope that the program will attract an audience of both Jews and non-Jews," declared Dr. Spack, "because we are all facing many of the same problems in bringing religious education to today's young people, and we believe that some of the ways CAJE is addressing these problems may be applicable to other situations as well."

Directed by two-time Emmy Award winner, Chalmers Dale, the program aims to encapsulate both the spirit and substance of the unique fiveday conference that brought almost two thousand Jewish educators from the U.S. and nine other countries to the campus of Northern Illinois University last August.

It stresses the rapport and cooperation that existed among the participants, who represented the entire Jewish ideological spectrum, from Orthodox to Reform.
