Friday, November 8, 1985 Alleged Nazi Ordered Extradited To Israel

NEW YORK (WNS) — A federal appeals court in Cincinnati ordered that alleged former Nazi death camp guard Ivan Demjanjuk be extradited to Israel to stand trial for crimes committed during the Holocaust. It was not immediately clear whether an appeal will be filed with the Supreme Court.

The court's ruling affirmed a lower court decision reached last April by U.S. District Court Judge Frank Battisti. Israel has issued a formal extradition request for Demjanjuk, though a final decision on extradition must be made by Secretary of State George Shultz.

Neal Sher, director of the Justice Department's Office of Special Investigations (OSI) said in Washington that the Department "will move as expeditiously as possible" to extradite Demanjuk to Israel. Without setting any timetable, Sher said, "it could be done very quickly."
