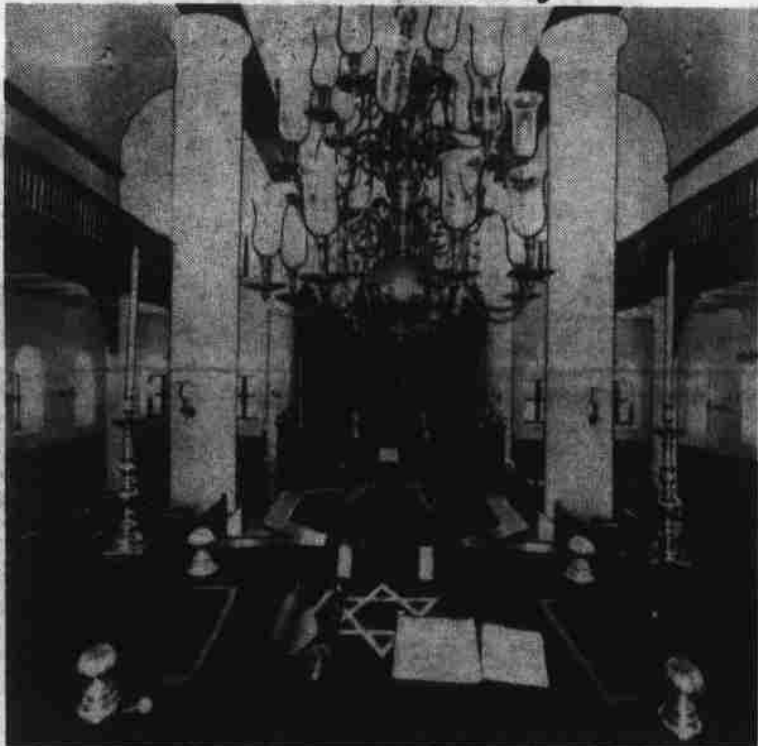

An Appeal To The Soviets

WASHINGTON (WNS) — Avital Sharansky, wife of imprisoned Soviet Jewish activist Anatoly Sharansky delivered a letter to Soviet leader Mikhail Gorbachev during his summit meeting with President Reagan in Geneva, appealing for the release of her husband.

Mrs. Sharansky, who began a three-day vigil across from the Soviet Embassy to draw attention to the plight of her husband and other Soviet
