

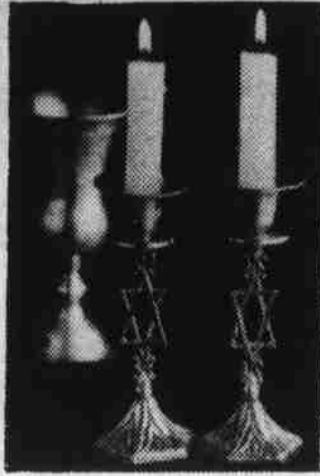
JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) — President Reagan received a petition from 75 Israeli Knesseters urging him to press for Soviet Jewish rights while meeting with Mikhail Gorbachev in Geneva. The petition, signed by MKs from all political parties, was handed to Ambassador Thomas Pickering by Soviet Jewry activists and members of the Knesset aliya committee, recently. The Ambassador reiterated past expressions of support by the President for Soviet Jewish rights, and said he was sure the issue would come up both at Geneva and in subsequent U.S. - Soviet contacts.

NEW YORK (WNS) — Representative of hi-tech industries in Israel interviewed hundreds of Israeli residents of the New York metropolitan area and potential American olim for 600 jobs open in the expanding science, engineering and computer industries, and signed 21 contracts by the end of the day. A similar job fair was held in Toronto last week.

WASHINGTON (WNS) — The Senate approved legislation to name a street in front of the soon to be built U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum "Raoul Wallenberg Place" in honor of the Swedish diplomat who saved over 100,000 Jews in Hungary during World War II. The naming of the street came as an amendment to the District of Columbia Appropriation Bill introduced by Sen. Carl Levin (D. Mich.). The House took similar action earlier this year.

NEW YORK (WNS) — Dr. David Steinberg, historian and former vice president of Brandeis University, was installed as President of Long Island University. He is succeeding Dr. Albert Bush-Brown who retired after 14 years. LIU has a student body of 22,000 and is scattered over 6 campuses.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — An official delegation representing the Jordanian Ministry of Agriculture visited Israel recently and spent four days talking to Arab farmers in the West Bank. Deputy Minister of Agriculture Avraham Katz-Oz said that this was the fourth such visit by an agricultural working group from Jordan which still maintains nominal responsibility for Arab residents in the West Bank and pays the salaries of local Arab civil servants and school teachers -- in addition to the salaries they are paid by Israel.

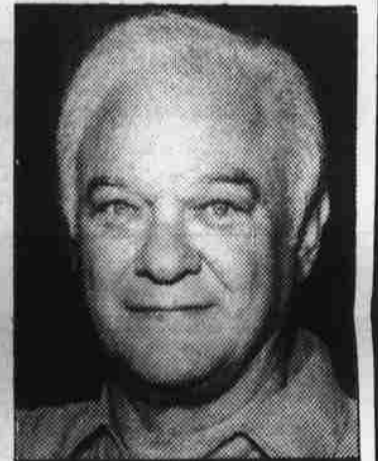
