Absentee voting for the December 10th Special Election will continue through December 3rd, at the office of the Clark County Election Department, 400 Las Vegas Boulevard South. This means of in-office absentee voting is made available for those people who will not be in town on Election Day and will not be at any permanent address sufficiently long enough to receive an absentee ballot by mail.

Requests for mail-out absentee ballots are currently being accepted at the Clark County Election Department and will be accepted through December 3rd, one week prior to Election Day. After December 3rd, absentee voting will be restricted, by law, to those people who, due to some emergency, are either confined to their homes or suddenly called out-of-town. The provisions for absentee ballot requests will extend through 5:00 P.M. on Election Day, December 10th. It is important that all absentee voters be aware that their voted ballots must be returned to the Clark County Election Department on or before 7:00 P.M. on Election Day for them to be counted. Ballots received after that time, cannot, by law, be counted.
