

Christian Group Urges Vatican To Recognize Israel

NEW YORK (WNS) — The National Christian Leadership Conference for Israel has told U.S. delegates to the extraordinary Synod of Bishops that the Vatican should recognize Israel and thereby promote the goals of the Second Vatican Council, according to a report by the NC News Service.

The New York-based group, whose leadership includes several Catholic supporters of Israel, urged diplomatic recognition in "An Appeal to the Bishops of the Synod." There would be no more effective way for the synod to draw attention to Vatican II goals not yet fully realized "than by urging the Holy

Father to announce the Vatican's willingness to establish full diplomatic ties with Israel," the statement said.

The Synod was called to assess the impact of Vatican II 20 years after its close.

The statement noted the "unprecedented growth in mutual understanding and respect between Christians and Jews" since Vatican II. "At the same time, however, Jews

Canadian Officials Headed To USSR For War Crimes Information

MONTREAL (WNS) — Former Supreme Court Justice Jules Deschenes announced that he is sending two of his deputies to the Soviet Union, and possibly other Eastern European countries to seek evidence related to the cases of eight

Canadians of Ukrainian origin suspected of war crimes while in the service of the Nazis during World War II, including crimes against Jews.

Deschenes was appointed by the government of Prime Minister Brian Mulroney earlier this year to serve as a one-man commission to investigate suspected Nazi war criminals who found haven in Canada after the war. He has been sifting evidence and conducting hearings on the matter for several months.

He has delegated two counsellors to his commission, Michael Meighen and Yves Fortiers, to collect evidence which he will weigh before submitting his report to the government at the end of December. They will have access to wartime

German as well as Soviet documents related to the cases under investigation and will visit other Communist bloc countries if necessary. They may also speak to eyewitnesses.

Deschenes' decision to extend his investigation to the Soviet Union aroused fierce protests from the organized Ukrainian community in Canada which contends that any documents from Soviet sources are untrustworthy. On the other hand, Jewish groups active in tracing Nazi war criminals, such as the Los Angeles Simon Wiesenthal Center, have affirmed that there are war criminals of Ukrainian origin residing in Canada.

have been troubled by the hesitancy of the Catholic Church to establish full diplomatic relations with the State of Israel," the statement said. The group said only "full and complete relations will convince the Jewish community that the church has finally cast aside once and for all its classical theology of the Jews as perpetual wanderers on the earth as punishment for killing Christ."

The Vatican has declared in the past it will not recognize Israel until there is peace in the Middle East. It also does not recognize Jordan, according to the NCNS report.

Mary Rosenwald, New York Philanthropist, Dead At 79

NEW YORK (WNS) — Mary Kurtz Rosenwald, Jewish community

leader and philanthropist and wife of William Rosenwald, a founder of the United Jewish Appeal, died here at the age of 79.

Born in Latvia, Mrs. Rosenwald and her family fled Leningrad to Berlin after the 1917 Russian Revolution and after Hitler's rise to power fled again to the United States. For many years she was noted for her personal generosity and was prominent as a philanthropist.
