

## **JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

NEW YORK (WNS) - For the first time in its history, two Jewish sisters are enrolled as cadets in the U.S. Military Academy at West Point. Sherri Langston, 19, joined her sister Brandy Langston, 20, who is a junior, this semester at the Academy. Both are from Walkill, N.Y. Before enrolling at West Point neither sister was associated with any synagogue. Now, however, both are active members of the West Point Jewish Chapel.

JERUSALEM (WNS) - The Israeli Cabinet approved the appointment of Likud MK Michael Dekel as Deputy Defense Minister and MK Rafael Pinhassi of Shass was appointed Deputy Minister of Social Affairs. Deke's main duties will pertain to settlements in the territories.

TORONTO (WNS) - The Ontario Court of Appeals ruled that a Jewish provincial government employee was legally within his rights in withholding dues from his union because he objected to its support for the PLO and a Palestinian homeland.

MONTREAL (WNS) - Two Jews were reelected in overwhelming Liberal Party election victory over the Parti Quebecois, which has been in office for nine years. Herbert Marx, the son of Jewish immigrants from Lithuania and a Harvard Law School graduate, was re-elected and is slated to become the first Jewish Justice Minister in Quebec. Also re-elected to the Provincial National Assembly was Maximilian Pollak, who received more than 12,000 votes.

JERUSALEM (WNS) - The Hebrew University of Jerusalem and the University of Madrid (La Ulniversidad Complutense de Madrid) last month signed an agreement providing for academic. scientific and cultural cooperation between the two institutions. Proposed for implementation in the 1985-86 academic year are joint activities between the two universities in the areas of Bible studies, history, Hebrew and Spanish language, Jewish philosophy, medicine and biology.

VIENNA (WNS) - Dr. Leon Zelman, head of the Jewish Welcome Service here, has been awarded the title Professor by the Austrian Minister of Education and Culture.
