## Upset Scored In Pro Arm Wrestling At Imperial Palace

It was a re-match of David and Goliath in the Pro Men's Heavyweight Arm Wrestling Championship held at the Imperial Palace Hotel & Casino. The score was once again David 1, Goliath 0. Suffering the slings and arrows of outrageous fortune was eight time champ Virgil Archiero of Cerritos, Ca, who was defeated by Bob Hopkins and John Walker to finish in 3rd

John Walker, the winner, was the lightest man in the tournament at 195#. Every other competitor weighed over 230#. Walker, from Atlanta, Ga, has won the Pro Men's Light Heavyweight title six times in the last seven years. Going up against the big men of the popular sport, Walker proved once again to be 195# of pure muscle with biceps that resemble steel-belted radials.

Second place finisher Bob Hopkins, of Ft. Pierce, Fl, plays football for the USFL Renegades. Hopkins weighs 260# and Virgil Arciero weighs 235#.

In the Pro Baseball Team Arm Wrestling Championship, 1st place and \$5,000 went to Willie Horton of the Chicago White Sox and Dave Owen of the Chicago Cubs. Montreal Expos Rick Renick and Tim Raines took \$3,000 for 2nd place and Seattle Mariners Spike Owens and Dave Henderson split \$2,000 for 3rd place. Kurt Bevacqua (San Diego Padres) and Butch Benton (Cleveland Indians) shared \$1,000 for their 4th place finish.

Competition was heated in the pro women arm wrestlers "Tournament of Champions." Lori Cole, of Hollywood, Ca, holder of several state and national titles for the last six years, defeated all comers. Marsha Monk, a health instructor from Omaha, Nb, took second and Maria Badaloni, a beliperson at the Imperial Palace, finished third. All will compete at the Imperial Palace in June, 1986, for the world championship against title-holder Sharon Brandef of Canada.

The three tournaments at the Imperial Palace were sponsored by Arm Wrestling International and Van Melle, Inc., maker of "Mentos," a candy with a unique chewy center. Lennon's death, Randy has been involved with the music of Lennon.

Randy's show business career began at the top. Just out of high school in Arizona, Randy auditioned in Los Angeles for a new show about the lives and careers of the four Beatles. With BEATLEMANIA, Randy headed for Broadway for a one and a half year run, then back to California with the West Coast company.

Next for Randy was Rain, the highly acclaimed band of Beatle sound-alikes formed for the express purpose of singing the soundtrack to Dick Clark's film, THE BIRTH OF THE BEATLES. Four British actors lip-synched to Rain's singing.

Randy appeared as young John Lennon in a movie called JAYNE MANSFIELD: AN AMERICAN TRAGEDY, which was never released, much to Randy's disappointment. While making the movie. Randy was stunned by Lennon's sudden death.

Back in New York, Randy got together with a band which had recorded with Lennon, the Elephant's Memory Band. With them, he put together a concert format show of Randy singing the best of Lennon's Beatle music and his later music. The result was IMAGINE, which played in Naw York and all over the East Coast to enthusiastic audiences.

In "Legends in Concert" Randy performs four songs: first a song Lennon recorded called "Rock and Roll Music" by Chuck Barry, then "Starting Over," the hit released immediately before John's death. He accompanies himself on guitar for the first two songs, then moves to a keyboard that seems to float onstage surrounded by a cloud of fog. The \$1 million special effects in "Legends in Concert" is put to good use for Lennon's signature song, "Imagine." Randy finishes with "All You Need Is Love."

"The John Lennon I present in 'Legends' never existed," says Randy. "He would never have performed alone in a spotlight in front of a band. He would have been with Yoko as he was on the album 'Double Fantasy.' I like to think of what I do as a 'single fantasy,' a look at Lennon as if he came back."
