JERUSALEM (WNS) — Premier Shimon Peres indicated strongly that Israel would take punitive action against the Palestinian terrorist gang responsible for the coordinated attacks on El Al passenger facilities at the Rome and Vienna airports on December 27 which killed 19 people, and wounded more than 110.

Addressing the Knesset for the first time since the tragedy, Peres lashed out at Libya, which he called a "murder state," and its leader Col. Muammar Quaddafi, raising speculation that Libya may be the target of Israeli reprisals whenever they are taken. Libya is known to harbor Abu Nidal, the terrorist leader believed to have masterminded the airport attacks.
