Arab Birth Rate In Israel **Exceeds That Of Jews**

JERUSALEM (WNS) - The Arab birth rate in Israel and the administered territories exceeds that of Jews. according to the latest figures released by the Central Bureau Statistics. Last- year there were 78,600 births among the population compared to 74,500 Jewish births.

About 24,000 of the Arabs were born in Israel proper and 30,400 in the West Bank. The balance of Arab births was in the Gaza Strip. Demographic experts expect this trend to continue in the coming years. Last year 3,472,000 Jews lived in and Israel the territories compared to two million Arabs under Israeli jurisdiction.

Arab Appointed Mayor Of Nablus

 After a period of three years in which the largest Arab city in the administered territories, Nablus, was run by an IDF officer, an Arab mayor was appointed to that office.

The new mayor is Zafer Al-Masri, 44, a well-to-do local businessman, a member of one of the wealthiest families in the West Bank. Another member of the family, Taher Al-Masri, is the Foreign Minister of Jordan. Zafer's uncle, Hikmai,


