Health Plan Of Nevada
Passes 50,000 Membership
Mark In Las Vegas

LAS VEGAS — Health Plan of Nevada (HPN), the state's largest and first federally-qualified health maintenance organization (HMO), recently surpassed the 50,000 membership mark in Southern Nevada.

HPN began enrolling members in Las Vegas in October 1982. A northern Nevada operation was begun in the Reno/Carson City area in January 1984.
