

High School Students At Boys Town Jerusalem Give 'Facelift' To 150-Year-Old Bikur Cholim Hospital

Soviet Jewish Mathematician Arrives In Israel

TEL AVIV (WNS) — Soviet Jewish mathematician Yasha Gorodetzky and his family arrived in Israel from Leningrad via Vienna, after a six-year struggle for permission to leave the Soviet Union.

The 40-year-old Leningrad mathematician, accompanied by his wife Pauline, 37, their four-year-old daughter and his mother-in-law said he did not know why he had suddenly been granted permission to leave Russia or if his exit visa heralded any change in Soviet policy toward Jewish emigration.

Gorodetzky has been a Zionist activist since 1980 and a refusnik since he was first refused an exit permit in 1983. He had in recent years become a central figure in the Soviet Jewish movement and was at one time put under house arrest by the KGB on suspicion of being an Israeli spy. But he was never imprisoned. He is not an observant Jew but worked

closely while in the Soviet Union with Rabbi Eliahu Essas, also 40, who came from Russia 12 days ago, whom he supported in demanding the right of Jews to study the Torah. Both have been described by other

Soviet Jewish emigrants as charismatic figures—probably allowed to leave by the Soviet authorities who realized they could not break their spirits.

Gorodetzky fought for the right of Soviet Jews to emigrate to Israel as an act of repatriation to the Jewish homeland

rather than on grounds such as family reunification. He also pushed the cause of Israeli citizenship for Soviet Jews requesting it, believing that this was one way of overcoming the problem of Soviet Jews receiving permission to leave for Israel but going on to other countries.
