"The Passover Celebration: A Haggadah For The Seder"

NEW YORK, N.Y. — The Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith has issued in time for Passover the fourth edition of "The Passover Celebration: A Haggadah for the Seder," designed for Christian inter-faith observances.

Prepared by Rabbi Leon Klenicki, director of ADL's Interfaith Affairs Department, in cooperation with the Liturgy Training Program of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Chicago, the 58-page publication highlights the major rituals and events associated with the centuries-old celebration of the liberation of the Jewish people from Egyptian bondage, the spiritual fulfillment at Mount Sinai, and the return to the Promised Land. The Haggadah includes a section com-

memorating the Holocaust and contains an introduction by Gabe Huck, director of the Liturgy Training Program, which elucidates the meaning of Passover for Christians.

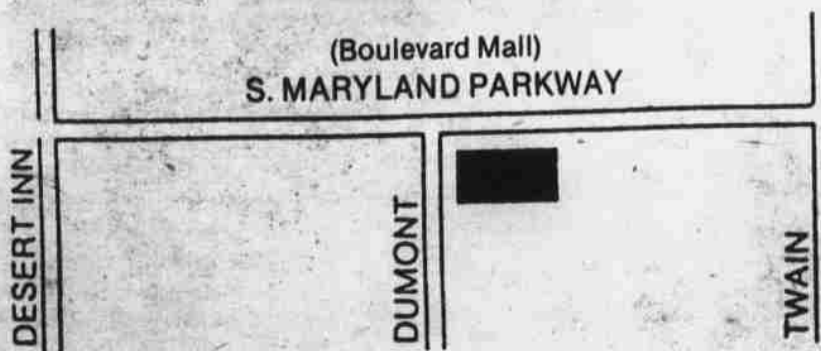
