WASHINGTON (WNS) — President Reagan told American Jewish leaders that he will never sell arms to moderate Arab countries that would threaten the security of Israel.

"I will not consider any measure, including arms sales to moderate Arab countries," if it endangered the security of Israel, Reagan told some 100 Jewish leaders attending a White House briefing for the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations.

His remarks came at the end of a speech in which he urged the support of the Jewish community for his request to Congress for \$100 million to aid the Contras in their opposition to the Sandinista government in Nicaragua.

Kenneth Bialkin, chairman of the Presidents' Conference, in expressing gratitude to the President for his remarks, voiced "concern" over providing arms to Arab countries that do not support the peace process. He said arms should only be sold to those Arab countries that "move into the direction of peace."

Bialkin suggested that if Egypt, Jordan and
