First Triplets Born In Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center Test Tube Baby Program

JERUSALEM — Two girls and a boy were born February 11 at Hadassah-Hebrew University Medical Center, the first triplets conceived and brought to term as a result of Hadassah's In Vitro

program. The babies, named Moshe, Miriam and Kochava, weighed 4.3 lbs., 3.5 lbs., and 4.2 lbs respectively, after being born during the mother's 33rd week of pregnancy.

According to Dr. Joseph Schenker, head of the Hadassah Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, the babies have not needed to be placed on any external support system, despite their low birth weights.

Both the 30-year-old mother, Nina Calderon, a hairdresser, and the father, 35-year-old truck driver Daniel Calderon, are sabras -- native-born Israelis -- and live in Raanana.

France Frees Two Palestinian Terrorists

PARIS (WANS) -France has released two Palestinian terrorists serving 15year prison sentences for murder, apparently as part of a deal with the terrorist group headed by Abu Nidal to refrain from terrorist acts inside France.

The deal reportedly dates back to 1982, after French police found conclusive evidence that the Nidal gang was responsible for the machinegun and grenade attack on a Jewish restaurant on the Rue Des Rosiers in the summer of 1982 in which six people were killed.

The Calderons have a son of ten, but needed Hadassah's In Vitro program to conceive again. Mrs. Calderon lived in the Maternity Department of the Hadassah Medical Center for the last six months of her pregnancy in order to carry the babies to term.

The birth of the triplets brings to 30 the number of babies born in Hadassah's In Vitro program, including two pairs of twins. The Hadassah In Vitro program was also responsible for a medical first last October when a healthy baby girl was born to a woman who was born without ovaries.
