Israeli Soldier Killed, Four Wounded In South Lebanon

JERUSALEM (WNS)

— An Israeli soldier was killed in south Lebanon and four others were wounded in a clash with terrorists near Batsil mountain at the western end of the border security zone, a military spokesman announced.

The dead soldier was identified as Cpt. Ronnen Malka of Migdal Haemek. The wounds suffered by the four other soldiers were described as light and medium. Malka was the first Israel Defense Force fatality since the IDF was pulled out of south Lebanon after a fruitless four-day search for two soldiers kidnapped by Shiite Moslem extremists.
