

Remains Found Of IDF Soldier Missing For 18 Months

TEL AVIV (WNS) — The remains of Sgt. David Manos, an Israeli soldier missing for 18 months, were buried at the military cemetery in Petach Tikva, a day after captured El Fatah terrorists who admitted to his murder led police to a cove in the West Bank where they had hidden the body.

The terrorists, arrested two weeks ago in Dir Balut near Nablus, re-enacted the kidnapping and murder. Manos was last seen alive on November 6, 1984, hitchhiking home from Haifa where he had been attending military courses. His killers picked him up near Ben Gurion Airport.

Manos' disappearance coincided with the disappearance of other IDF personnel and massive searches were

conducted in the areas where they were last seen. A woman soldier whose body was found in a wooded area of Mt. Carmel was evidently raped and murdered.

But police were not certain at the time that Manos was a victim of foul play. It was suggested in the media

that he was a drug user or trafficker, that he had been seen in the company of prostitutes after he was reported missing and that he was involved with criminal elements. Those rumors added to the anguish of his family. But Manos, it turned out, had been an exemplary soldier and was buried with full military honors.

In favor: Algeria, Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Bulgaria, Byelorussia, Cameroon, China, Colombia, Congo, Cyprus, Ethiopia, Gambia, East Germany, India, Jordan, Kenya, Mauritania, Mozambique, Nicaragua, Peru, Philippines, Senegal, Sri Lanka, Syria, Soviet Union.

Against: Australia, Belgium, Costa Rica, West Germany, Ireland, Norway, United Kingdom, United States.

Abstentions: Austria, France, Japan, Lesotho, Liberia, Mexico, Spain.

Ephraim Dowek, Israel's Observer at the session, branded the text "exclusively political in nature" and that "it did not only go beyond the mandate of the Commission, but also it should be rejected and be deemed to be irreceivable." He let it be known that Israel was aware of the fact that the "usual automatic majority would be used to steam roll it to adoption."

against, with 13 abstentions. Here, too, we had practically the same alignments for and against.

Having thus voted separately on the above paragraphs entailing bitter debates and satanic diatribes aimed at the Jewish State, the Commission turned for a vote of the draft resolution as a whole including, of course, the three anti-Israeli, anti-U.S. paragraphs. This is what we got: 28 voted in favor, 8 against, with only 7 abstentions.
